Recommend that consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 17-29-541 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2016-2017 school year and the first semester of the 2017-2018 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
      - 2. Recommend that consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 17-39-281 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2016-2017 school year and all of the 2017-2018 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
